

1. Enter the assignment and click "Add Rubric."

Creating the Rubric



- 1. Add a title
- 2. Click here to edit the criteria text.
- 3. Click here to edit the text and add points for each "Ratings" cell.
- 4. Click between "Ratings" cells to add another cell between.
- 5. Add the total possible points here for each criteria.
- 6. Click "Add Criterion" to add another criterion (row) to the rubric.
- 7. When finished click "Create Rubric."

Other Rubric Settings

- I'll write free-form comments when assessing students: This setting removes the "Ratings" cells in the middle, leaving only the overall criteria description and the total points possible for the criteria.
- Use this rubric for assignment grading (recommended): This setting will auto-fill the student's score when using the rubric to grade. This setting is recommended.
- Hide score total for assessment results: This setting keeps the total accumulated score hidden to the instructor while using the rubric.

Adding a Rubric to a Discussion




- 1. Click the gear at the top right of the discussion.
